

Compost Site Information for Racine RC Club Members

General Information and Instructions

Keys for the compost site gate and building are kept in the clubs key lock box.

The compost site is to be opened by a club member on Wednesdays no later than 12pm and must be kept open until 4pm.

All club members are required to fulfill two (2), two (2) hour shifts each year to maintain membership eligibility.

All club members are to voluntarily sign up for compost duties prior to the opening day of the compost site or the compost director will assign duty days that will be the member's responsibility to fulfill.

All club members should expect a phone call confirming their duty assignment day a few days prior to your workday.

A duty roster will be posted in the club display case and in the compost facility building, please sign your name over the other persons name that is working with you and have them do the same for you. This is a means of having someone else verify your attendance and you verify theirs. The purpose for this is to give us the tracking ability to take measures as determined by the club by-laws against any member not fulfilling their duties. Your help and cooperation is appreciated.

Site Information

All vehicles entering the compost must be stopped to verify Mt. Pleasant citizenship, if they do not have a white sticker you must verify their address to the list that is provided by Mt. Pleasant and kept in the compost building.

After verifying the address the citizen should be given a white sticker to place on the back of their rear-view mirror so that their ID and address does not have to be verified each time.

Non Mt. Pleasant citizens are not allowed to use the compost facility unless they provide a paid “drop” card EVERY time they come into the site.

Contractors must provide a paid “drop” card EVERY time they come into the site regardless of citizenship.

NO LOGS or Limbs over 4” in diameter are allowed....EVER

Grass clippings and leaves are to be kept separate from branches and sticks

All grass clippings and leaves should be emptied from bags and the bags discarded into the provided receptacle.

NO trash or garbage is allowed to be mixed in with the yard waste....EVER

NO rocks, bricks, stones, stumps are allowed.....EVER

Try to ensure that the patrons pile their yard waste on the piles as cleanly as possible, do not allow yard waste and limbs and branches to be mixed.

It may be necessary to go out and “remind” the patrons to keep things as neat as possible and to not mix the yard wastes.

Ensure that the compost building and gates are locked and the facility keys are returned to the club key lock box at the end of the day. (4pm)

FOR SAFETY REASONS.....If anyone ever becomes belligerent, allow them to enter the site and dump their waste. Simply record their license plate number and call the compost director. We will always have the village address any issues.
